He even scored quite well in the area of gender parity, particularly in the field of girls' enrolment in secondary schools. But more worryingly a recent tendency is negatively affecting his education profile, with a downward trend of the number of children completing the primary cycle and poor performances in exams. Strong affirmative action will need to be taken quickly if he wants to get back on track with the EFA programme. His relatively high spending and the support he's been getting through the Fast-Track Initiative should help with this - as long as it continues to be strong and predictable. Let's see him in the top half of the global rankings next year!
