### Teacher's Remarks:

What makes him rise out of this pack is his record-breaking progress in the field of primary enrolment, which he has managed to increase by close to 78%. The flip side of the coin to this success is that he now has to match it with other levels. The disastrous access rate to secondary education is living proof that his system is defective somewhere along the line. Teacher training as well as addressing the strong urban and rural inequalities could be part of the solution.
