### Teacher's Remarks:

Uruguay shows some of the best indicators in the Latin-American region, achieving the top position in Latin America's ranking. Primary education is free and virtually universal, although secondary education is not in the same situation. Illiteracy rates in this country run by Tabaré Vázquez do not reach 2% of the population, the number of teachers is sufficient and textbooks are provided free. The challenges that he has to face are the corruption perception and the low civil society participation in education policies. Tabaré has done really well and we are proud of him!
